NOW, THEREFORE, now All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of

Two Hundred Ninety (\$290.00) Dollars,
to me paid by the said D. B. Traxler

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the
said D. B. Traxler

"All that tract or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of
South Carolina, known as Lot No. 13 on plat of property of Country Club Estates made by Dalton
& Neves October, 1926, said plat being recorded in Plat Book G, page 190 and 191, and having the
following courses and distances according to said plat:

Beginning at an iron pin on Douglass Drive, joint corner of Lots Nos. 13 and 14, and
running thence with line of Lot No. 14, N. 23-30 W. 150 feet to iron pin; thence S. 66-38 W. 50
feet to corner of Lot No. 12; thence with line of Lot No. 12, S. 23-30 E. 150 feet to Douglass
Drive; thence with Douglass Drive N. 66-38 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner."
