Tolbert among themselves, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these Presents by ERNEST TOLBERT (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained and sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Ernest Tolbert, his heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina and more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in center of a county road, corner Lot No. 2, and runs thence along the center of said road N. 1.00 W. 328 feet; thence N. 18.30 W. 57 feet; thence S. 58.45 W. 1070 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 4.00 W. 216 feet to corner lot No. 4; thence along line of lot No. 4 S. 80.15 W. 1063 feet to a stone; thence S. 5 E. 241.5 feet on branch; thence S. 45.10 E. 463 feet to stake; thence N. 69.30 E. 1513 feet to a stake; thence N. 66.45 E. 252 feet to beginning corner, containing 18.95 acres, more or less.
