BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of DeOyley Avenue at joint front corner of Lots #38 and #39, said pin being 306.5 feet Northeast of iron pin located in the Northwest corner of Lot #43 on the East boundary of W.J. Iselin (or formerly) property; thence S. 0-13 E. 200 feet to an iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots #38 and #39 on the North boundary of Robert I. Woodside (or formerly) property; thence N. 89-47 E. 90 feet to an iron pin at rear center of Lot #37; thence N. 0-13 W. 200 feet to an iron pin at front center of Lot #37 on the South side of DeOyley Avenue; Thence S. 89-47 W. 90 feet along said Avenue to an iron pin at joint front corner of Lots #38 and #39, the point of beginning.
