

TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA) RENUNCIATION OF DOWER
 COUNTY OF GREENVILLE)

WHEREAS, by deed dated November 4, 1942, recorded in the RMC office for Greenville County, Mamie A. Kennemore, Corie A. Herndon, Irene A. Robertson, John Alewine and Alma A. Boling, grantors, conveyed unto R. E. Compton, grantee, the tract of land as hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, Varie Alewine, the wife of the said John Alewine, duly renounced her dower on said deed, however, through typographical error, the names of the five grantors was inserted in said dower as the grantee in place of the said R. E. Compton;

NOW THEREFORE, in order to correct said defect, said Varie Alewine executes the following dower: I, C. Victor Pyle, a Notary Public for South Carolina, do hereby certify unto all whom it may concern, that Mrs. Varie Alewine, the wife of the within named John Alewine, did this day appear before me, and upon being privately and separately examined by me, did declare that she does freely, Voluntarily, and without any compulsion, dread or fear of any person or persons whomsoever, renounce, release, and forever relinquish unto the within named R. E. Compton, his heirs and assigns, all her interest and estate, and also all her right and claim of Dower of, in or to all and singular the premises within mentioned and released, and being more particularly described as follows:

"All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in O'Neal Township, County and State aforesaid, about three miles west from Double Springs, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stone on branch; thence up said branch to a stone; thence S. $1\frac{1}{2}$ E., $4\frac{1}{2}$ chs. to poplar; thence S. $42\frac{1}{2}$ E., 5.6 chs. to black gum; thence N. $73\text{-}3/4$ E., 6.85 chs. to stake; thence N. 8 E., 3.34 chs. to stone; thence S. 82 E., 1.58 chs. to stone; thence N. 8 E., 5.00 chs. to stone; thence N. $64\text{-}2/5$ W., 7.45 chs. to stone; thence N. $18\text{-}1/3$ W., 31.85 chs. to stone on branch; thence up the meanders of branch to the left hand prong from fork, adjoining lands now or formerly owned by J. N. Morgan, M. W. Goodlett, A. N. Gilreath, and others, and containing 46.2 acres, more or less.
