THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C.

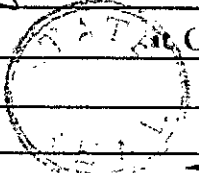

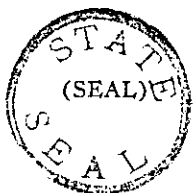
