leased, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. W. Jones and Hiley  
B. Jones, and their heirs and assigns,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 120 as shown on plat of  
Westview Heights of Pride & Patton Land Company, as revised by Dalton and Neves,  
Engineers, in June 1941, and recorded in the Office of R. M. C. for Greenville  
County in Plat Book "M" at Page 11, and being more particularly described, according  
to said plat, as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeastern side of Wilburn Avenue,  
joint front corner of Lots Nos. 119 and 120, and running thence with the joint  
lines of said lots, N. 43-30 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 46-34 E. 61  
feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots Nos. 120 and 149; thence along the rear  
lines of Lots Nos. 149, 150 and 150-A, S. 43-30 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the  
Northeastern side of Wilburn Avenue; thence with said Avenue, N. 46-34 W. 61 feet  
to the beginning corner.

The grantees are to pay 1947 taxes.
