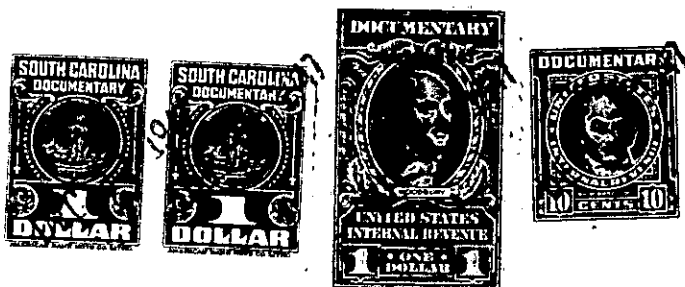

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. W. Simpson  
of the County of greenville

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred (\$600.00)

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by W. D. Elliott

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents  
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. D. Elliott, his heirs and assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, on Henderson Street, and being known and designated  
as lot No. 86 in Block "C" of Plat Book "A" at page 460, recorded in R. M. C.  
Office for said Greenville County, and having the following metes and bounds  
according to said plat:

" Beginning at a point on Henderson Street 186 feet from intersection  
of New Cut Road and Henderson Street, and running thence with said Henderson  
Street, N. 1/2 E. 50 feet to corner of lots 85 and 86; thence with joint line  
of lots 85 and 86, N. 89-30 W. 150 feet to a 10 foot Alley and joint rear  
corner of lots 85 and 86; thence with said 10 foot Alley, S. 1/2 W. 50 feet  
to joint corner of lots 86 and 87; thence with joint line of lots 86 and 87,  
S. 89-30 E. 150 feet to the beginning corner on Henderson Street, and being  
known and designated as lot No. 86 of Block "C" in Plat Book "A", page 460,  
and being the identical lot conveyed by deed to me by Emma Huff, November 30,  
1935, which is recorded in Volume 331, at page 449 in the R. M. C. Office for  
Greenville County, State aforesaid.
