As a part of the consideration for this conveyance the Grantees assume and agree to pay that mortgage given by Wilber D. Connelley to Carolina Housing and Mortgage Corporation, August 4, 1947, for the original sum of \$5800.00, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Mortgage Book 367, Page 43, on which there is now due a balance of \$5615.16.
