All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State
of South Carolina, being known and designated as Paris Mountain Orchards
Tract No. 2 as shown by a Plat thereof made by G. A. Ellis dated January
1947, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin 680 feet from cross roads of the Piney & Paris
Mountain roads, thence S. 1 W. 280 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 75
