

10-16 W 137 feet, thence Eastwardly along the Southern and Southwestern limits of Sections 2, 3, 4 and 5 of Judson Mills Village, plats of each by Dalton and Neves, Surveyors, recorded in Plat Book K in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County, to a point the Southeast corner of Lot No. 89 as shown upon the plat of said Section 5, thence S 78-22 E 16.9 feet to a corner of the Methodist Church lot, thence S 51-12 E 175 feet to an iron pin on the Anderson Road. From within said boundaries, a small lot 50' x 100' at the corner of Third Avenue and an unnamed street one block South of Sixth Street has been conveyed to Boy Scouts of America.

13. The following numbered lots as shown upon a plat entitled "Map of Judson Mills No. 2 Village" dated March 1939 and recorded in said office in Plat Book K, at pages 1 and 2: Lots 2 and 15 of Block D, Lots 1, 2 and 3 of Block E; Lots 1, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18 and 19 of Block H; and in addition to the numbered lots in Block E the land lying South of said Lots 1, 2 and 3 and North of the property conveyed by Judson Mills to Gaylord Container Company, said strip extending from 8th Avenue on the West and 20th Street on the East.

14. All that certain parcel or tract of land lying immediately north of Block H as shown on "Map of Judson Mills No. 2 Village" being bounded on the West by 8th Avenue, on the North by 23rd Street (proposed), on the East by the right-of-way of P. & N. Railroad, and on the South by the lots fronting upon the South side of 22nd Street as shown upon said map.

15. Also all that tract or parcel of land lying immediately West, 8th Avenue intervening, of the tract described immediately above, bounded on the East by 8th Avenue, on the South by the unnamed street between 8th and 9th Avenues, on the West by the line of 9th Avenue, and on the North by property of _____.

16. All that parcel or tract of land containing 2.92 acres, more or less, lying on the East side of Brushy Creek and the South side of the Easley Bridge Road, its Eastern line being the old line of George's Road, and bounded on the East and South by lands of H. K. Townes.

17. All that certain lot or parcel of land on the South side of Goodrich Street, formerly Judson Road, being a part of Lot No. 5 of Property of J. O. Heatherly as shown on a plat recorded in R.M.C. office of Greenville County in Plat Book E, at page 238, and particularly described in Deed from W. S. Ward to Judson Mills dated November 4, 1921 and recorded in Deed Book 73, at Page 273, said lot fronting on Goodrich Street for about 55 feet and being about 105 feet in depth.

18. Those two certain lots in the Southwest sector of the junction of Easley Bridge Road and Fifth Avenue, designated as Lots 53 and 54 upon the plat of Section 2 of Judson Mills Village made by Dalton and Neves, Surveyors, dated November, 1939, and recorded in said office in Plat Book K at Page 25. Said lots front for 420 feet along the South side of Easley Bridge Road and for 295 feet along the West side of Fifth Avenue.

Also all that certain parcel or tract of land situate in School District 6 E., Gantt Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, about three (3) miles West of Greenville Court House on the South side of Bent Bridge Road containing 5 acres, more or less, and being more
