

do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J.C. Caldwell

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Llountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, bounded now or formerly as follows:

On the North by Tract No 1 of the subdivision of the Ralph S. Crowell lands, which tract was conveyed by deed of even date to J.C. Caldwell; On the East by tract No. 1 and tract No. 3 (sold by deed of even date to R. V. Reynolds) or said Crowell lands; On the South by lands now or formerly of W.W. Solesbee Estate; On the West by lands of Jack Fowler, and being more particularly described as rollows:

Being lot No. 2 of the sub-division of the lands of Halph S. Crowell acqui acquired by deed from Victor M. Lontgomery, dated July 6,1940, recorded in Book 9-T, page 146, Office of R. West 160 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 1 of the Growell lands, conveyed to J.C. Caldwell; thence with the Caldwell line 3 calls as follows: South 79 deg. 30 min. East 990 feet to an iron bin In the baved Landrum-Gowansville Hoad; thence with said road and the Caldwell line South 9 deg. 27 min. 'est 338 feet; South 6 deg. 48 min.
