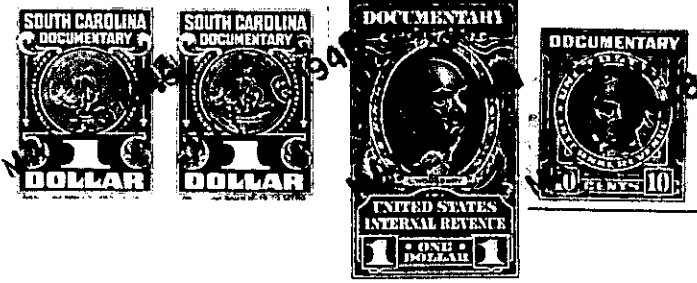

by CHARLES R. WHITE, likewise of Greenville County, South Carolina,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Charles R. White, his heirs and assigns forever, all my right, title and interest, the same being an undivided one-half interest, in and to

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, about one mile from Augusta Road, and about one mile

East of West Gantt school, on the Old Mill Road, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Old Mill Road, at rear corner of property now or formerly belonging to E. P. Kerns, and running thence in a Northerly direction with rear line of said Kerns property two hundred (200) feet to a stake; thence in a westerly direction in a line parallel with Old Mill Road eighty (80) feet to stake; thence in a southerly direction two hundred (200) feet to stake on Old Mill Road; thence with Old Mill Road in an Easterly direction eighty (80) feet to beginning corner; being a portion of the property conveyed to E. P. Kerns by E. Inman, Master, by deed dated July 16th, 1941, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book No. 235, at page 215; and being the same property conveyed to me by deed of E. P. Kerns.
