That I, Martha Edwards in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Two Hundred (\$1200.00) DOLLARS,

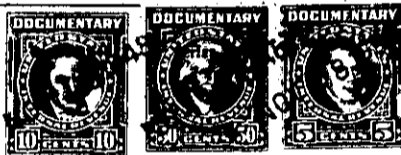
to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Fred D. Lott and Bessie D. Lott, their heirs and assigns forever, the following described property:

All those two certain pieces, parcels or lots of land near the City of Greenville in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the West side of Watson Road, just East of Super Highway leading to Spartanburg and shown as all of Lots 30 and 31 on Plat of property of Estate of Vance Edwards, prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, December 1946, as revised June 1947, which plat is recorded in Plat Book P, at pages 128, 129, in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit;

Beginning at a point in the center of Watson Road, which point is the joint front corner of Lots 29 and 30 and running thence along the joint rear of said Lots, S. 80-12 W. 228 feet to an iron pin in line of Lot 44; thence with the line of Lot 44, S. 9-42 E. 200 feet to an iron pin at rear corner of Lot 32; thence along line of Lot 32 N. 80-12 E. 228 feet to a point in center of said Watson Road, thence along the center of said road N. 9-42 W. 200 feet to point of beginning.

Being two of the lots conveyed to Martha J. Edwards by deed of Robert J. Edwards, et al, dated July 8, 1947, recorded in Deed Book 315 at page 159, in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.
