WHEREAS, the Overbrook Water & Sewer Sub-District of Greenville, South Carolina, is an organized and existing political subdivision and as such a municipal corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of South Carolina, and

WHEREAS, Said District has heretofore acquired certain land easements, rights of way, sewer and water lines and other real and personal properties in connection with its operations, and

WHEREAS, On petition duly filed by a majority of the freeholders within said district, an election was duly held on November 4, 1948 whereby the Laurens Road, Old Spartanburg Road and Super Highway areas, including the entire area of Overbrook Water & Sewer Sub-District, voted to become annexed to and become a part of the City of Greenville, South Carolina, on the terms and provisions set forth in said petition, and

WHEREAS, The election was also duly carried favorable to the annexation by the voters in the City of Greenville, South Carolina, and the Greenville City Council has duly declared the election as having carried in favor of the annexation and has, by proper resolution of the Greenville City Council, dated November 23, 1948 annexed the Laurens Road, Old Spartanburg Road and Super Highway areas, including the entire area of Overbrook Water & Sewer Sub-District to the City of Greenville as a part and parcel thereof effective January 1, 1949 (beginning at the hour of Midnight, December 31, 1948), and

WHEREAS, Among others, it was provided in the petition and annexation resolution that

"The City of Greenville shall receive and own title to the Overbrook-Eastover Water and Sewer Sub-District's present assets together with all properties used and useful in the operation thereof including all water hydrants and service lines heretofore furnished or provided by the
