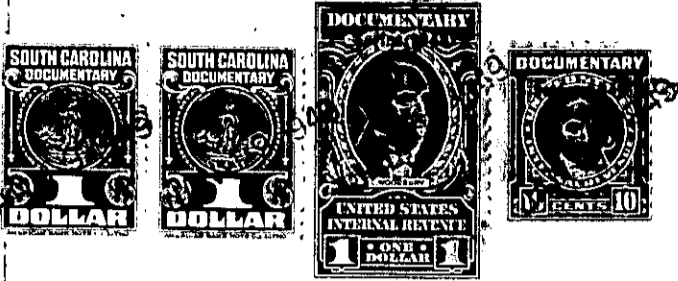

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, ROBERT W. WELLS,

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

JOHN L. HENDERSON

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said JOHN L. HENDERSON Heirs and Assigns, Forever:

All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the Western side of Druid Street in a subdivision known as Stone Estates, Unit No. 2, being known and designated as Lots No. 6, 7 and 8, Block B, of said subdivision, said property being described according to a plat of Stone Estates, Unit No. 2, prepared by C. M. Furman, Jr., C. E., dated December, 1931, and having, according to the aforementioned plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the Western side of Druid Street at the joint front corner of Lots No. 5 and 6, and running thence along the common line of said lots, N. 81-35 W. 150 feet to a point; thence N. 11-22 E. along the rear line of Lots No. 6, 7 and 8, 75 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of Lots No. 8 and 9; thence along the common line of said last mentioned lots, S. 81-35 E. 150 feet to a point on the Western side of Druid Street, the joint front corner of Lots No. 8 and 9; thence along the Western side of Druid Street, S. 11-22 W. 75 feet to the beginning corner.
