

CHARTER
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS, BENNY F. HYATT AND THOMAS A. EVINS
both of Spartanburg, S. C.

did on the 8th day of February, 1950, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration,
signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is GREENVILLE U-DRIVE-IT SYSTEM

THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is the purchase, sale,
renting and servicing of automobiles; the procuring and maintenance
of repair, parking and servicing facilities for automotive equipment;
the purchase and sale of real estate; together with any and all
activities in any wise related to any of the purposes hereinabove
set forth.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is --- Fifteen Hundred (\$1,500.00) -Dollars
payable in cash forthwith.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is One Hundred fifty (150)
of the par value of Ten (\$10.00) --- Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 6th day of
February, 1950, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the follow-
ing were elected directors:

Benny F. Hyatt, Thomas A. Evins and Elizabeth S. Evins

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, Benny F. Hyatt
as Vice-President, Thomas A. Evins ; as Secretary, Thomas A. Evins
as Treasurer, Benny F. Hyatt

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1942, and all amendments
thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by
bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice
of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Greenville News

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

said Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of
