

VOL 402 PAGE 456 In case of slight damage by fire, or otherwise, without fault of the lessee, the lessor is responsible for the repairs, which he may make in a reasonable time, and the lease will be extended for such additional time and to the extent that the lessee cannot use the premises; and for such period payment of rent will be adjusted or suspended as is proper. In case of serious damage the lease is thereby cancelled, and should the parties desire a new lease, they shall then negotiate one.

The lessor will carry insurance on the building. The lessee will carry insurance on the stock, fixtures and equipment, in amounts sufficient to protect the lessor.

In case of default in payment of the rent, for a period of sixty days, the lessor may cancel this lease at his option.

The lessee agrees to all the terms and conditions of this lease, and further agrees that he will pay rent as herein above specified, and will truly and faithfully perform all of the terms and conditions of the lease.
