

BEGINNING at a stake on the West side of Evergreen Street (formerly known as Douglas Avenue), which stake is 290 feet from the intersection of Franklin Road and Evergreen Street, and running thence with Evergreen Street, N. 44-02 W., 60 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 46-03 W., 120 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots Nos. 69 and 70; thence S.44-02.E., 60 feet to a stake, which stake is 290 feet from Franklin Road; thence N. 46-03 E., 120 feet to a stake, the beginning corner.

The property herein conveyed is the rear 60 feet portion of each of lots Nos. 70 and 71, as shown on said Plat; lot No. 70 having been conveyed to John P. Taylor by R. E. Benson by deed dated June 3; 1936, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 184, page 407. Lot No. 71 having been conveyed to John P. Taylor by W. F.
