all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, located about three miles west from Greer, and being a small corner off of the rear (the eastern part) of the same tract of land that was conveyed to R. L. Wynn by deed recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 41 at page 471, being bounded on the northern side by lands of A. R. Owens, on the east by lands of A. R. Owens, on the south by lands of J. T. Stokes and on the west by a tract being conveyed this day to Gaines W. Copeland and Clara Belle W. Copeland, and lying on both sides of a small branch, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:-

Beginning on an iron pin on the A. R. Owens line and joint corner of the tract being conveyed to Gaines W. Copeland and Clara Belle W. Copeland, and runs thence with the A. R. Owens line, S. 47-10 E. 34 feet to an iron pin in the edge of a gully; thence with another A. R. Owens line S. 16-30 E. 90 feet to an iron pin near the edge of the small branch, J. T. Stokes corner; thence with the Stokes line S. 65-15 W. 102 feet to an iron pin at the root of a large Sweet Gum Tree, joint corner of the tract being conveyed to Gaines W. Copeland and Clara Belle W. Cope; and; thence with the line of this tract N. 15-30 E. 157 feet to the beginning corner, and containing Sixteen One-hundredths (0.16) of one acre, more or less.
