Office for Greenville County in Plat Book Page 159, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

The above described property was conveyed to The City of Greenville by deeds from Sam R. Zimmerman, Jr. and Elizabeth D. Zimmerman dated January 26, 1946, and January 15, 1946, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Book of Deeds 286, Page 213 and 286, Page 214, respectively. The property above described was condemned by The City of Greenville for use in connection with the construction of a street now known as the Stone Avenue By-Pass and was conveyed to The City of Greenville by said grantors subsequent to the condemnation. The City of Greenville is not using the above described property as a part of the right-of-way for said Stone Avenue By-Pass and by this conveyance The City of Greenville conveys to the grantees all of its title and interest in and to said property.
