

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Miriam W. Pickell and Walter L. Pickell, Jr.

all that piece, parcel or lot of land more with the buildings Taxwasks and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, Greenville County. State of South Carolina

Beginning at a stake on the Northeast corner of Rutherford and Croft Streets and running thence with the North side of Croft Street S 85-39 E 150 feet to a stake, thence N 1-41 E, 69 feet and 4 inches to a stake; thence in a line parallel with Croft Street N 85-39 W 150 feet to a stake on Rutherford Street; thence with Rutherford street S 1-41 W 69 feet and 4 inches to the beginning corner as shown on a plat recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A page 34, and being the west 150 feet of the tract conveyed to Beaulah H. Seawell by E. E. Stone and L. H. Cary on February 9, 1920 as recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in deed Book 53 at page 294.

Save and excepting a deed of Right of Way granted the City of Greenville to the following segment of this property: exception described as: beginning at the North edge of W. Croft Street and running thence North along Rutherford Street 70.2 feet to the common corner between the property of Beulah H. Seawell and that of Nathan A. and Rose L. Ridgeway, thence Easterly along the seawell and Ridgeway property line 6.8 feet to a point, thence South across the Seawell property 69.3 feet to a point on W. Croft Street, thence Westerly along West Croft street 7.0 feet to the point of beginning on Rutherford Street.

The original deed made to me misspelled my first name as "Beaulah" and this is to warrant that I am the same individual named in the deed from E. E. Stone and L. H. Cary - deed dated Feb. 9, 1920 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office in Greenville County, South Carolina, deed book 53 at page 294 and that the correct spelling of my first name is "Beulah.
