I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, J. V. Jones



on or about the 22nd day of March in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and fifty-one exhibited his County complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against

Parie Lee Green, et al,

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 9th day of May 19 51, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Laurel Creek Baptist Church for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. E-1964)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$1150.00

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said Laurel Creek Baptist Church

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, South Carolina, on the North side of the Laurens Road near the Laurel Creek School and having, according to plat made by Dalton and Neves, February, 1951, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of the Laurens Road, corner of H. J. Southern and running thence with Southern line, N. 60-49 E. 202.8 feet to an iron pin; thence still with the Southern line, S. 84-58 E. 370.2 feet to an iron pin in the center of a plantation road; thence along said plantation road, S. 31-23 N. 175.8 feet to an iron pin still in the center of said road; thence along the line of the Laurel Creek School property, S. 44-26 E. 33.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 60-48 W. 229 feet to an iron pin on the North side of the Woodruff Road, corner of Laurel Creek Baptist Church property; thence with the North side of the Woodruff Road and the Laurens Road, N. 51-55 W. 353 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning, and comprising 2.30 acres."
