M. C. Office for Greenville County. Said lot has the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING on the southern side of Hampton Circle at the corner of Lot 23 and running thence with the southern side of Hampton Circle N. 43 E. 85 feet to pin corner of Lot 25; thence with Lot 25, S. 47 E. 274.9 feet to a pin rear corner of Lot 25 on the LaBoon line; thence S. 19-41 W. 92.6 feet to a pin rear corner of Lot 23; thence with Lot 23, N. 47 W. 311.4 feet to the beginning corner.
