all that piece, parcel or lot of land in lying and situate in Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, and known as tract 2, containing 7.20 Acres, of the estate of J. B. Hawkins, Jr. according to plat made by Dalton and Neves in January, 1940, and more particularly described according to said plat as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the Uncochee Road 14.3 feet from iron in its joint corners of tracts 2 and 3, thence N 33-22 E 35.3 feet along the line of tract 3 to the rear corner thereof, thence N 33-22 E 35.3 feet to joint, thence S 5-15 W 1/3 feet along line of tract 2 to corner of tract, thence S 5-22 W 1/3 feet along the line of tract 1 across iron line at or near the edge of Uncochee road and continuing to point in wild road 14 feet from said iron line, thence S 7-3 W along said Uncochee road 200 feet to a point, thence S 7-3 W along said line 14 feet to the point of beginning, being a portion of the tract deeded to J.
