All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland

Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, on the Tugaloo Road, about  $9\frac{1}{2}$  miles north from Travelers Rest, known as the McMahan place, on the waters of Meadow Creek, containing 94 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds as per plat made by W.P. Morrow on September 23, 1933:
