HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said Lois M. Holifield, all the right, title and interest of the
Defendant, James Paul Holifield, in and to the following described real
estate:
All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina and having the following metes and bounds:
BEGINNING at an iron pin on Butler Avenue at the corner of the H. A.
Garrett lot and thence running along Butler Avenue N. 21-50 E. 65 feet to
an iron pin at the corner of the W. A. Wallace lot; thence S. 67-15 E.
137 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of a fence S. 30-20 E. 31.8
feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of the fence S. 22-45 W. 58.5
feet to an iron pin; thence N. 62-40 W. 160.6 feet to the beginning corner.
