

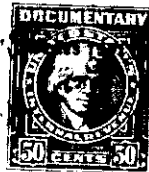

O. Shaver, their heirs and assigns, forever:**

All that lot of land situate on the Southeast side of Crosby Circle, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, shown as Lot 200 on plat of Paramount Park, made by Piedmont Engineering Service, July 1949, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "W", at page 57, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeast side of Crosby Circle, at joint front corner of Lots 199 and 200, and running thence with the line of Lot 199, S 26-00 E 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N 64-00 E 70 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 201, N 26-00 W 150 feet to an iron pin on the Southeast side of Crosby Circle; thence along the Southeast side of Crosby Circle, S 64-00 W 70 feet to the beginning corner.
