Certain tract of land commonly known as the "Mc Combs-Poole" tract, located on the waters of South Saluda River in Cleveland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, said plot of ground being more particularly as follows:

Beginning at a stake on Geer Highway, approximately Two Hundred Feet (200') North and East from the Hickory Corner, common to the Dalton Tract and the said "Mc Combs-Poole" Tract, and running thence N-20° 45' W. 1050 Feet to a stone, thence N. 29° 50' E. 200 Feet to a stone, Thence S-35° E 1132 Feet to a stake in the old Caesar's Head Road, thence up and over the said Caesar's Head Road 423 Feet to the stake, the beginning corner, containing 7 acres, more or less,
