to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Frances Pilgrim, her heirs and assigns forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 98 of a subdivision known as Englewood Estates, Section "A", as shown by a plat thereof, dated October, 1951, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville, South Carolina in Plat Book Y at Page 140, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin joint corners of Lots No. 98 and 99 and running then ce along the line of said Lot No. 99, S. 2-30 W. 207 feet to iron pin at point in line of Lot No. 101; thence along the line of Lot No. 101, S. 87-30 E. 100 feet to iron pin at rear of Lot No. 96; thence along the line of said Lot No. 96, N. 2-30 E. 207 feet to iron pin on Cambridge Drive; thence with the said Cambridge Drive N. 87-30 W. 100 feet to point of beginning.

THIS deed is made subject to the following restrictions:

- 1. No house is to be erected costing less than \$5,000.00.
2. No house is to be built closer than 50 feet to the street.
3. No temporary house is to be erected on said lot.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and her Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s') Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
