
THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, COUNTY OF GREENVILLE











County. State of South Carolina, lying and being on the Northwest side of the South Saluda River and being designated as lot number 5, according to Plate of I.P. Chastein Surveyor, dated April 8, 1949, (said plate)

South Saluda River and being designated as lot number 3, according to Plat of J.B. Chastain, Surveyor, dated April 8, 1949, (said plat to be recorded) and having the following metes and bounds according to said plat.

BEGINNING at a point in the middle of Poplar Spring Branch approximately 15 feet from the Greenville water line and running thence N. 52 E. 66 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 60 E. 181 feet to the middle of said South Saluda River; thence in a Southwesterly direction down the middle course of said river 70 feet to the middle of said river where said Poplar Spring Branch empties into said river; thence in a Northwesterly direction following the meanderings of said Poplar Spring Branch a distance of approximately 215 feet to the point of beginning and containing 26/100 acres more or less.

A right-of-way is reserved on the Northwest side of 25 feet for the purpose of running a private road along all lots as shown on the plat by Mr. Chastain and the Grantor agrees to reserve a similar 25 feet right-of-way along all other lots which are sold for said road.

This is a part of the same tract of land which was conveyed to the Grantor herein by William F. Evans by Deed dated January 2, 1952, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 448, at Page 271.
