All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 7 of the property of Walter W. Goldsmith according to a plat thereof made by Madison H. Woodward, dated April, 1946, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeast side of Paine Street, joint front corner of Lots 6 and 7, which pin is 51 feet from the northeast corner of the intersection of Paine Street with Rector Street, and running thence along the joint line of said Lots 6 and 7, N. 33-52 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the line of Lot 5; thence along the line of that lot, S. 56-08 E. 50 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 8; thence along the line of that lot, S. 33-52 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the northeast side of Paine Street; thence along Paine Street, N. 56-08 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
