All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying and being in the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No.45 as shown on Plat of Rutherford Park, recorded in Plat Book P at Page 109, and described as follows: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of Welter Lane, joint front corner of Lots 44 and 45, and running thence with joint line of said lots, N.54-30 W.188.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S.27-42 W. 60.6 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 45 and 46; thence with joint line of said lots, S.54-30 E. 179.7 feet to an iron pin on Western side of Welter Lane; thence with said lane, N. 35-30 E. 60 feet to the point of beginning.
