

insurance of whatever type covering my life, property or liability or in which I may have any interest as owner or otherwise; to execute, deliver and cash checks drawn on any bank deposit standing in my name; to invest and re-invest any and all monies belonging to me which may come into his hands; to employ agents, attorneys and counsel and determine and pay to them reasonable compensation for their services, and generally to do and transact any and all business for me and in my name as fully as I might do if personally present and acting.

And I do ratify and approve all acts and things which my said attorney may do in the premises.

This power of attorney shall remain in force and effect until cancelled in writing upon the face hereof and upon the record hereof in the Office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, South Carolina, should this power of attorney be recorded in that office and this power of attorney or the record thereof in the Office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, South Carolina, or any authenticated copy of either shall be the full and complete warrant and authority for any person whomsoever to deal with my said attorney in the premises.

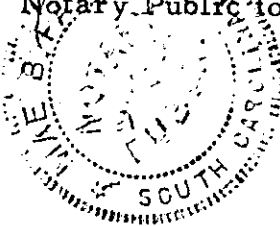
