KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That SOUTHERN BLEACHERY ALD PRINT WORKS, INC., a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Delaware, (grantor), in consideration of \$1,040.21 in hand paid by DUME FOLER COMPANY, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of New Jersey, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell, assign, transfer and deliver unto said Duke Power Company, its successors and assigns, the following described property, easements, rights and privileges, to uit:

- (a) Certain electrical equipment, apparatus, appliances and material of the grantor set out on the inventory hereto attached and made a part of this bill of sale and now located in the area known as the mill village of grantor at Taylors, S. C.
- (b) The right, privilege and easement to go in and upon the lands of the grantor within and adjacent to the above mentioned mill village, and to construct, maintain and operate in; upon and through said premises, in a proper manner, with poles, wires and other necessary apparatus and appliances, lines for the purpose of transmitting power by electricity and for telephone purposes where lines for such purposes are now located, and to construct, maintain and operate extensions of such lines and additional lines for such purposes along and across the streets, roads and alleys within and adjacent to said premises and along and across the rear, front and sides of each of the lots into which the said lands of grantor are now or may hereafter be subdivided; together with the right to connect said lines in a reasonably direct and proper manner with the premises of customers to be served by said lines; together with the right at all times to enter upon said premises of the grantor for the purpose of inspecting said lines and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right to keep said lines clear of all trees and other obstructions, other than structures now existing, that may in any way endanger or interfere with the proper maintenance and operation of the same.
