CONTRACT OF SALE

This agreement entered into this day of September, 1957, by Claude Hale and Bernie Fanning, as Executors of the Estate of Mary E. Brady, hereinafter referred to Sellers, and T. J. Howard, hereinafter referred to as Purchaser.

WITHESSETH
