AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that this agreement is made and entered into this 10th day of February 1953, by and between S. T. Turner and Harry Crumbley;

W I T N E S S E T H

The said S. T. Turner, in consideration of the right and privilege granted to him, his heirs and assigns forever, by the said Harry Crumbley to run a water line across the front of the property belonging to the said Harry Crumbley on Highway No. 253, about eight and one-half miles from the Greenville County Court House, in the County and State aforesaid, does hereby give and grant the privilege to tap on to said water line free of any further consideration, to the said Harry Crumbley, compensation for said water to be paid by the said Harry Crumbley at the same rate as charged by the City of Greenville.

The said Harry Crumbley does further grant unto the said S. T. Turner, his heirs and assigns, the right and privilege to come on to said property and to repair and maintain said water line.

All of the aforesaid grants and privileges to the said Harry Crumbley by the said S. T. Turner are conditioned upon the City of Greenville not objecting to same.
