that the Lessee shall erect upon the leased premises and adjoining property owned or leased by the Lessee, free of liens or rights thereto (except mortgage liens to secure valid debts as herein provided) and of claims of contractors, mechanics, laborers, or materialmen, a new multi-storied building of substantial construction adapted to office, mercantile, commercial, and/or hotel purposes. Said building shall be constructed of good material, erected in a good workmanlike manner and be ready for occupancy on or before December 31, 1962. The Lessee shall not be liable for damages or otherwise in any way to the Lessor because of its failure to construct said building, but if said building is not completed within said time, the Lessor, at his option, may terminate this lease as herein provided at any time between January 1, 1963, and January 1, 1964.

In the event the Lessee does construct said building as herein provided, the Lessee agrees that, for the first twenty-five (25) years of the term hereof, it will properly maintain the same, and in the event of the removal or destruction thereof within said twenty-five (25) years, it will replace said building with another building which shall be comparable in type and construction with the building so removed or destroyed. At any time after December 31, 1977, the Lessee shall have the right, without liability to the Lessor, to remove any such building or part thereof (whether the same be the initial building herein mentioned or a replacement thereof) from the leased premises and shall not be required to replace or restore the same, whether said removal is occasioned by the voluntary act or acts of the Lessee or is the result of fire or other casualty; provided, however, that if on January 1, 2042, said building or a replacement thereof is still standing upon the premises hereby leased, the Lessee may not during the remainder of the term hereof, voluntarily remove the same without replacing it with a building at least equal to the then value of the building
