That I, Henry P. Willimon in consideration of the sum of Forty-nine & 50/100 (\$49.50) in the State aforesaid.

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Wendell Willimon and Enola K. Williamson, their heirs and assigns, forever;

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land being known and designated as Lot No. 294 of Conestee as shown by a Plat thereof, made by Madison H. Woodward, Engineer, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book of Plats, T, at Page 383 and 384; said lot having the courses, distances, metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on West Lake Circle at joint front corner of Lots No. 294 and 295 and running thence along the line of said Lot No. 295, N. 50 W. 189.1 feet to iron pin; thence S. 1-0 W. 150 feet to iron pin at back corner of Lot No. 293; thence along the line of said Lot No. 293, N. 89 E. 140 feet to iron pin on West Lake Circle; thence running with the said West Lake Circle N. 1-0 E. 23 feet to point of beginning.

THAT the lands shall not be sold, rented or otherwise disposed to any person or African descent or negro. No residence to cost less than Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars, shall be erected on said lot nearer than twenty-five (25) feet to the front line, and no residence shall be built on any lot unless said lot has fifty (50) feet, or more, frontage.

GRANTEE to pay taxes for the year 1953.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and their Heirs and Assigns forever.
