N. Seaborn now deceased which is on a plat which is filed with E. Inman, Master to be a part of the record in the case of Rosa Greene, Adm. D. B. N. C. T. A. and Individually, vs Tecora Washington, et al, and which is filed in Apartment 132, File 14, Probate Court of Greenville County. Said lot has the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at lot designated as A. R. Seaborn lot on the South side of Anderson Road, thence with the South side of Anderson Road N. 63-52 E. 65 feet to the corner of lot designated as Alease Seaborn lot; thence with Alease Seaborn lot S. 22-14 E. 75 feet, more or less, to a pin at corner of Lot No. 5 according to said plat; thence with the rear line of Lot 5 and 4 at S. 63-52 W. 65 feet to a pin in the rear line of Lot 4 at corner of M.
