properly payable to me by the United States, including, but not restricted to, allowances and reimbursements for transportation of dependents or for shipment of household effects as authorized by law or Navy or other regulations; and to receive, endorse and collect the proceeds of checks payable to the order of the undersigned drawn on the Treasurer of the United States for whatever account, and to execute in the name and on behalf of the undersigned, all bonds, indemnities, applications, or other documents, which may be required by law or regulation to secure the issuance of duplicates of such checks, and to give full discharges for same.

- 9. To take possession, and order the removal and shipment, of any of my property from any post, warehouse, depot, dock, or other place of storage or safekeeping, governmental or private; and to execute and deliver any release, voucher, receipt, shipping ticket, certificate, or other instrument necessary or convenient for such purpose.
- 10. To institute, prosecute, defend, compromise, arbitrate, and dispose of legal, equitable, or administrative hearings, actions, suits, attachments, arrests, distresses, or other proceedings, or otherwise engage in litigation in connection with any of the powers granted in this Power of Attorney.
- 11. To act as my attorney-in-fact or proxy in respect to any policy of insurance on my life and in that capacity to exercise any right, privilege, or option which I may have thereunder or pertaining thereto; excluding, however, the right to change the beneficiary, the right to change the method of payment of the insurance proceeds, and the right to make a cash surrender of the policy as distinguished from a surrender of the policy for loan, conversion, or other purposes as provided therein.
- 12. To prepare, execute, and file income and other tax returns, Federal or State, of any kind or nature, and other governmental reports, applications, requests, or documents.
- 13. To act as my attorney or proxy in respect to any stocks, shares, bonds, or other instruments, rights, or interests, that I may now or hereafter hold.
- 14. To engage and dismiss agents, counsel, and employees, and to appoint and remove at pleasure any substitute for, or agent of my said attorney, in respect to all or any of the matter or things herein mentioned and upon such terms as my attorney shall think fit.
- 15. To borrow money and to execute in my name any instrument evidencing indebtedness incurred on my behalf, and this is intended to include power to exercise on my behalf and in my name any rights or privileges which I may have under the Soldiers and Sailors Civil Relief Act of 1940 as amended and extended, and under the G. I. Bill of Rights Act, and to extend and renew the same, as well as any indebtedness heretofore incurred by me, and for which I am in any manner liable.
- 16. To execute requests for payment on my behalf on any United States Savings Bonds registered in my name as owner or co-owner, and to receive, endorse, and collect the proceeds of checks payable to my order drawn on the Treasurer of the United States in payment of the redemption value of or of the interest on any United States Savings Bonds registered in my name as owner or co-owner.
