



It being the intention of the undersigned by this instrument to consent to the closing in the manner aforesaid by the Peoples National Bank of Greenville, South Carolina of the portion of said alley extending from the north side of North Laurens Street in a westerly direction a distance of 62.5 feet and to constituting the remaining portion of said alley as a public alley as aforesaid.
