All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, on the southwest side of LaFayette Street near Green Avenue, and being known and designated as Lot No. 21 of a subdivision known as Washington Heights as shown on plat thereof made by C. M. Furman, Jr. on February 3, 1922 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book F, at page 54, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
