CHARTER  
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

516

WHEREAS, L. A. NELSON AND M. L. KA LAN

both of Greenville, S. C.

did on the 13th, day of April, 1953, file with the Secretary of State a written declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is L. A. Nelson, Inc.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is Greenville, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which they propose to carry on is to conduct a general contracting and construction business, including the building, constructing, enlarging, repairing, remodeling or otherwise engaging in any work upon buildings, roads, structures, dams, oil wells, or manufacturing plants; to engage in iron, steel, brick, concrete, stone, cement, masonry and such construction; to execute contracts or assignments of contracts herefor or therefor; to furnish labor and/or furnish the necessary materials, and supplies required in connection generally to do any and all things hereinabove set forth, and to do any and all things hereinabove set forth in the course of doing business for a corporation to do, including the filing of articles of incorporation.

FIFTH: That the amount of capital stock is Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) - - - - - Dollars, payable in cash, equipment, and services.

SIXTH: That the number of shares to be issued is One Hundred Thousand (100,000) - - - - - shares.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the shareholders will be held on March 13, 1953, at the office of the corporation, at which meeting the following were elected directors:

L. A. Nelson, Mrs. Mary Nelson, and M. L. Lan

EIGHTH: That subsequently to the election of the above-named directors, L. A. Nelson

as Vice-President, Mrs. Mary Nelson as Secretary, and M. L. Lan

as Treasurer, L. A. Nelson

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 133 of the Statutes of South Carolina relating to documents thereto have been duly fulfilled, and that the corporation has 20 per cent of the capital stock subscribed and paid in, and that the same is held by the two bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent of the capital stock, and that the corporation has filed a copy of the notice of the intention to file this charter with the Secretary of State, and with the Greenville Piedmont

a newspaper to be selected by the corporation.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK T. ORTON, Secretary of State, do hereby certify that the foregoing is true according to the law of South Carolina, under the name of or for the purpose indicated in the charter, and that the corporation is authorized to commence business under their charter, and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyances or Clerk of Court in each county where the corporation does business.
