It is understood and agreed that grantee wherever used in this instrument, means the person or persons, firm, corporation, or company to whom the timber, and other property and rights hereinbefore mentioned and described are hereby conveyed, and said term shall include, and bind the administrators, executors, successors or assigns thereof, whether so expressed in terms or not; and the term grantor wherever used in this instrument shall be construed to mean the person or persons, firm, corporation or company hereby making the conveyance of the said timber and the other property and rights and easements hereinbefore mentioned and conveyed, and this term also shall include and bind the executors, administrators, successors, or assigns, thereof, as the case may require, whether so stated in terms or not.
