All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Fairview Township in the town of Fountain Inn, and being known and designated as Lot No. 5 of the property of Floyd Weathers, et al. as shown on plat thereof made by W.
