LEASE AGREEMENT

This lease agreement entered into this 29th day of May, 1954 by and between W. H. Sutherland, Jr., of Greenville, S. C., hereinafter referred to as Lessor, and McCullough Oil Co., Inc. a South Carolina corporation with its principal place of business at Greenville, S. C., hereinafter referred to as the Lessee,

## WITNESSETH

That for and in the consideration of the mutual promises, covenants and agreements hereinafter set forth, it is agreed as follows:

1. That the lessor does hereby lease and demise unto the lessee and the lessee does hereby take and rent from the lessor the following described premises:

"All that piece parcel or lot of land on the Southeast side of the Camp (Rutherford) Road about 500 feet Northeast of the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, S. C., in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being a part of the property conveyed to me by Howard N. Covington and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the edge of the right of way of the Camp Road 50 ft. Southwest of the point where a small branch passes under the Camp Road, via culvert, and running thence in a Northeasterly direction with the right-of-way of Camp Road 225 ft. to iron pin; thence at 45 degree angle in a general southernly direction to iron pin, which pin will be 25 ft. Southeast of the right-of-way of the said Camp Road, and running thence in a line perpendicular with Camp Road 125 ft. to iron pin in line of property of Lessor; thence in a Southwesterly direction on a line parallel with the Camp Road 200 ft. to iron pin to be located; thence in a Northwesterly direction in a line purpendicular to the Camp Rd. 150 ft. to the beginning corner. The said areabing a rectangular plot of land measuring 200 ft. x 150 ft. with a flare or driveway line of 25 ft. on the Northeast corner thereof fronting on the Camp Road.

This plat of ground is to be definitely shown by a plat to be prepared by a surveyor, and same may be recorded either at the option of the lessee or lessor.

2. To have and to hold the above described lot of land for and during a term of five (5) years beginning with June 1, 1954 and ending at midnight
