I, J. A. Henry, Receiver of Poinsett Brick and Tile Company, a corporation duly organized under and by virtue of the laws of the State of South Carolina, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Reconstruction Finance Corporation on or about the 18 day of January, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and fifty-four exhibited its complaint in the United States District Court for the Western District of South Carolina, Greenville Division (Civil Action No. 1558) against Poinsett Brick and Tile Company, a Corporation, demanding judgment in relation to the real estate and personal property hereinafter mentioned and described (and also seeking appointment of a receiver for the Poinsett Brick and Tile Company, and the Honorable C. C. M. [unclear], United States District Judge for the Western District of South Carolina, under and by the terms of his order of February 12, 1954, duly appointed J. A. Henry as receiver of all the property of the Poinsett Brick and Tile Company, a Corporation, as will more fully appear by reference to said order filed in the office of the Clerk of said District Court in said action on February 13, 1954); and the said complaint was heard or to be heard on the 12th day of February 1954, and the judgment rendered therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, the substance of which is decreed that the said real estate and personal property, hereinafter more fully described, be sold by J. A. Henry, Receiver of the said Poinsett Brick and Tile Company, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said complaint and the evidence thereto on file in said Court, with a plan of the said real estate, and the said property duly advertised the said real estate and personal property for sale by public auction on the 19th day of April, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and fifty-four, did then openly and publicly, according to the custom of law, and in pursuance of said decree, sell and dispose of the same unto [unclear] for the sum of FIFTY THOUSAND (50,000) DOLLARS, the highest bidder therefor.
