WITNESSETH:

That for the term and upon the terms and conditions set forth in that certain written service station lease bearing date February 18, 1954, from Lessor to Lessee, the Lessor has leased, and does hereby lease unto

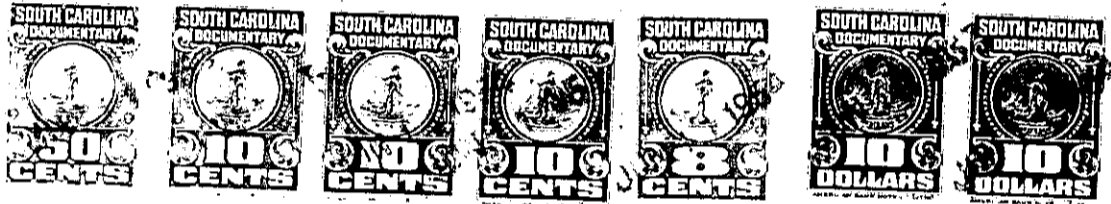
Lessee a tract of land, with the improvements thereon, near Greenville

described as follows:

Beginning at the southwesterly corner of the intersection of Woodside Avenue and Morgan Street and running N 77° 26' W along the southerly right-of-way line of Morgan Street a distance of 92.1 feet to a point; thence S 11° 51' W a distance of 60 feet to a point; thence N 77° 34' W a distance of 49 feet to a point; thence S 13° 29' W a distance of 60.1 feet to a point; thence S 77° 34' E a distance of 139.6 feet to the westerly right-of-way line of Woodside Avenue; thence N 13° 23' E along the westerly right-of-way line of Woodside Avenue a distance of 120 feet to point of beginning.



Together with all appurtenances thereto, and all right, title and interest of Lessor in and to any and all roads, streets and ways bounding said premises.

Said lease contains an option to Lessee to purchase said premises.

It is understood that the service station lease above referred to constitutes the complete agreement of lease between Lessor and Lessee.
