SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is

BERT MILLS VEND\_A\_MATIC DISTRIBUTORS, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is

GHEENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to sell and distribute automatic vending machines, including the taking of all steps desirable to promote such sale and distribution, and the doing of all things incidental thereto.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is One Thousand (\$1,000.00) - - - - - Dollars may also at the call of the Directors.
