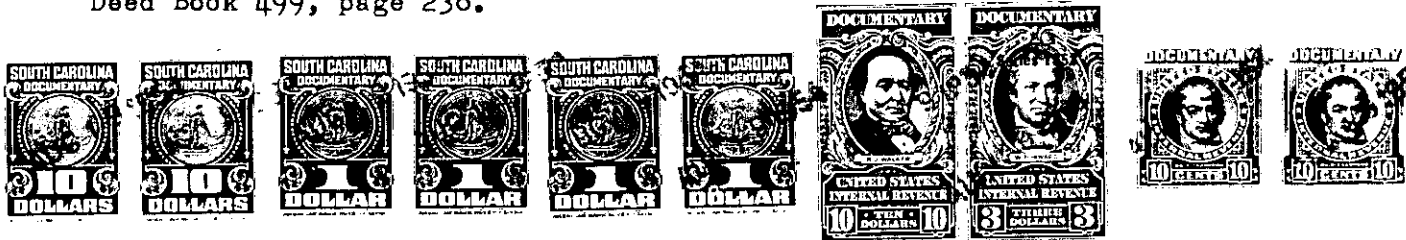
Know All Men by These Presents:

GARRISON, his Heirs and Assigns, forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 26 in a subdivision known as Pecan Terrace as shown on Plat thereof recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "GG", page 9, and being more particularly described according to a survey by Piedmont Engineering Service, August 18, 1954, as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwest side of the White Horse Road, corner of Lot No. 25; thence with the line of said lot, S. 53-16 W. 177.2 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 31-22 W. 65 feet to an iron pin in line of Lot No. 27; thence with the line of said lot, N. 51-30 E. 168.7 feet to an iron pin on the White Horse Road; thence with said Road, S. 38-40 E. 70 feet to the beginning.
